

Escape to The Florida Orchestra

While many orchestras across the country remain dark, The Florida Orchestra has performed dozens of live concerts since October, with many more on the schedule through May, all following CDC guidelines for health and safety. It's easy to escape to The Florida Orchestra LIVE in the concert hall or LIVE streaming from your couch.

"The Florida Orchestra is doing what once seemed impossible: performing live concerts safely at the Mahaffey Theater," said TFO President & CEO Mark Cantrell. "Months ago, we could not have anticipated just how powerful and moving this season would be. In an uncertain world, this music has anchored us with comfort and hope, and we are proud to bring our community together for the final phase of our reimagined 2020/21 season."

Under the leadership of Music Director Michael Francis, highlights of the premier Tampa Bay Times Masterworks series include Mendelssohn's Violin Concerto (April 10- & 11), Dvorak's New World Symphony (May 1) and a special concert for these tumultuous times themed Serenity (March 13 & 14). Two Masterworks: Soundwaves concerts – a silver lining of splitting the orchestra into smaller ensembles for safety – will feature Mozart's Horn Concerto (Feb. 20) and Mozart's Gran Partita (March 13 & 14).

Highlights of the Raymond James Pops series include **Broadway Sings** (Feb 13), **Gershwin's Rhapsody in Blue performed by Stuart Malina** (May 22 & 23), and **Dan Black & The (TFO) Brass Cats** (Feb. 27), led by TFO Resident Conductor Daniel Black. The morning Coffee series will explore music by Beethoven, Mozart, Prokofiev and more.

Health and safety measures for all concerts include mandatory face masks that cover the nose and mouth, spaced seating in pairs, extensive testing for musicians and frequent sanitizing of equipment and seats. Concerts are shorter with no intermission only at The Duke Energy Center for the Arts/Mahaffey Theater with 25 percent capacity.

Anyone can watch select concerts via live stream or on demand on any device from anywhere in the country. It's free and easy to register at FloridaOrchestra.org/livestreams. Invented by Jules Alciatore, the second-generation proprietor of Antoine's restaurant in New Orleans, Oysters Rockefeller have become a house specialty in fine restaurants all over the world. The key to this recipe is to use the freshest oysters and herbs available.

Ingredients

24 Large Shucked Oysters on the half shell

1 Cup Unsalted Butter, divided

1/2 Cup Chopped Flat-Leaf Parsley

1/4 Cup Chopped Green Onions

1/4 Cup Fennel Bulb, chopped

1 Tsp Chopped Fresh Chervil or Tarragon

2-3 Chopped Celery Leaves

2 Cups Watercress or Baby Spinach Leaves

1/3 Cup Fine Dry Breadcrumbs

2 Tbs Pernod or other anise-flavored liqueur

1/4 Tsp Salt

1/4 Tsp Pepper

1/8 Tsp Hot Sauce

2 Lbs Rock Salt

2 Lemon Wedges for Garnish

PREPARATION

Melt 3 tablespoons butter in a skillet over medium-high heat; add parsley and next 4 ingredients. Sauté 2 to 3 minutes. Add watercress, and cook 2 to 3 minutes or until wilted. Cool. Pulse parsley mixture in food processor with the remaining 13 tablespoons butter, breadcrumbs, and liqueur until smooth, stopping to scrape down sides.



Add salt, pepper, and hot sauce. Fill pie pans or a large baking sheet with 2 pounds rock salt. Dampen salt slightly, and arrange oysters on the beds of salt.

Top each oyster with a spoonful of the parsley mixture.




